

# JERUSALEM AT THE TIME OF CHRIST

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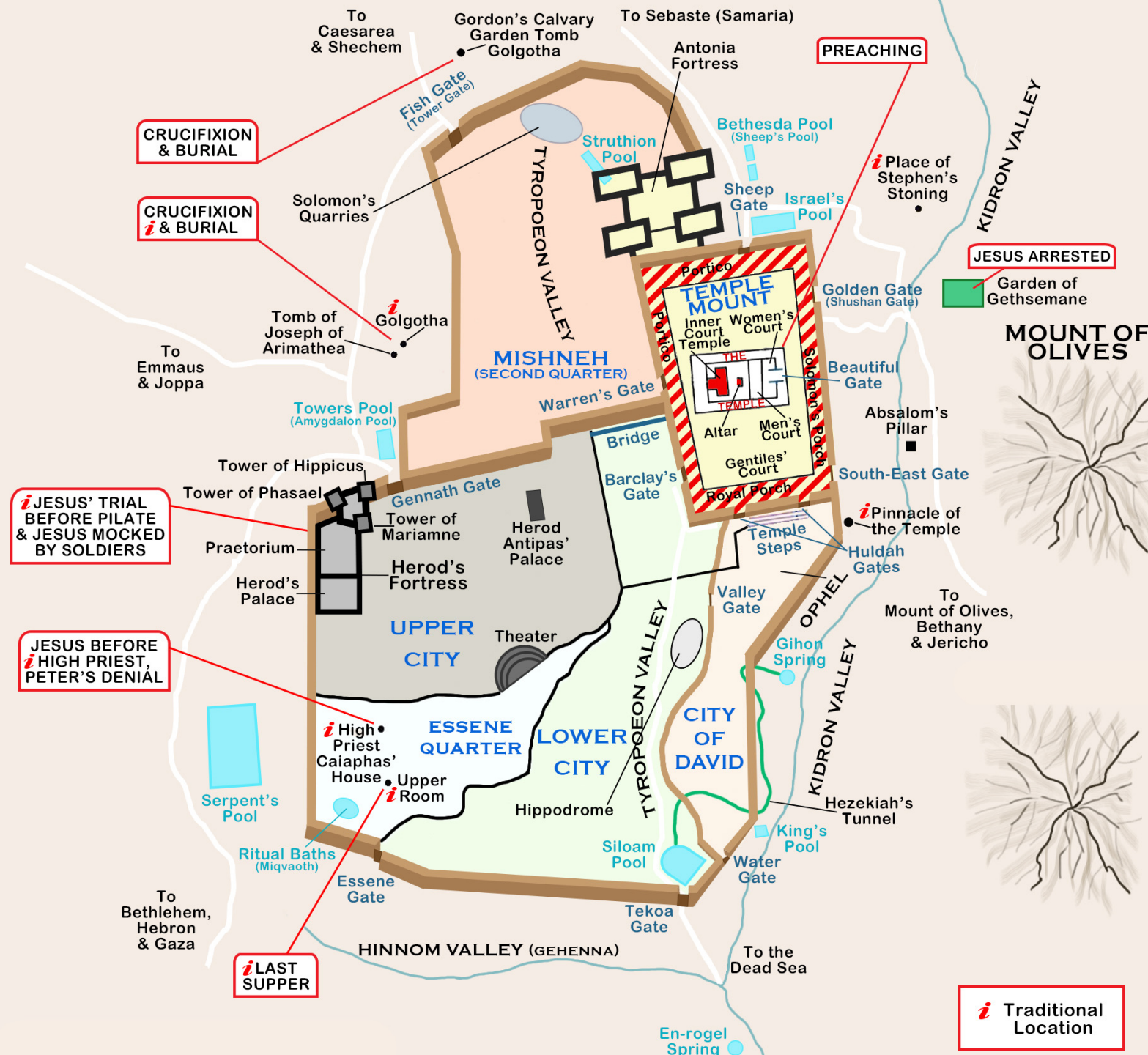
Golgotha/Tomb: Traditional site just to the west of the walls; now Church of the Holy Sepulchre

Garden Tomb: Alternate site to the north of the walls; believed by some (Protestants) to be authentic historical site

Temple Mount: Now the site of Al Aqsa Mosque and Dome of the Rock

Bethany: Town of Mary, Martha, and Lazarus, on the southeastern slope of the Mount of Olives

Hinnom Valley: South and west of the walls—Gehenna—trash heaps; symbol of hell

# HOLY SITES TODAY

**Red:** Old City of Jerusalem; present walls approx. 500 years old. Significant boundary differences since time of Christ.

Church of Holy Sepulchre = traditional site of Golgotha and burial of Christ

Temple Mount holy to Jews, Christians, and Muslims

**Blue:** Kidron Valley

**Green:** Mount of Olives

Bethphage: = often mentioned alongside Bethany (home of Mary, Martha, Lazarus), about 1 mile east
